

PREMARITAL CARE

This brief discussion paper is designed to give the participants a clearer view of what lays ahead maritally. It is not intended to reveal how much you don't know of one another, but rather how much you do know. Some of the questions may surprise you and others not. Whatever you make of the study is down to your honesty and willingness to communicate frankly with one another. Your answers will neither shock nor surprise your discussion group leader, so feel free to have your say and above all, remember the process is about YOU and not us.

The questionnaire includes the following topics:

Instructions

Please read instructions before beginning.

The premarital inventory is designed to aid an engaged couple in examining their feelings and expectations about a marital relationship. Choose the answer which most accurately complies with your opinion or feelings about the statement. Draw a circle around the appropriate answer.

A = agree D = disagree U = uncertain

For example, if you agree with question 1, circle A, as in example. If you disagree with question 2, circle D, as in example, if you are uncertain with question 3, circle U, as in example.

There is no particularly ‘correct’ answer, but the answer you feel happiest with, or think is the most appropriate for you. These are to be answered on your own, without consultation with your fiancé. It is important that you give the answer that is true for you.

Pray before you answer, asking God to help you.

Note: The results of this will be strictly confidential and will be returned at the end of sessions.

This inventory will help in the premarital counselling you are about to undertake.

It will give your counsellors an idea of your relationship with your future partner, an idea of your understanding of what is required for marriage and will help to make the time spent with counsellors fruitful. Any areas of difficulty or misunderstanding can also be worked through so that you will have a better understanding of marriage, of each other and of how you can build and develop your relationship more fully.

God wants you to have a marriage relationship that is good and blessed and brings glory to Him. As you open up to Him, He will indeed help to stimulate, enrich and strengthen your relationship.

As you grow as a couple in your understanding and relationship with Jesus Christ, you will find marriage can enhance your faith in Him. Marriage is a picture of Jesus Christ’s relationship with His people, Eph 5:21-33.
